The course was developed using key concepts from the book; Helping Your Child with Fears and Worries; by Lucy Willetts and Cathy Creswell. The aim of the programme is to help parents build a range of CBT informed (Cognitive Behavioural Therapy) strategies to help them and their child manage their anxiety to increase their sense of wellbeing.
