Dear Parents and Carers,

I hope that you are well and wrapping up as the weather has changed so suddenly. Please could I ask that you make sure your children are coming to school with appropriate jackets (clearly labelled) for the weather. Last week, we trialled hot dinners and they were a success. We therefore hope to return to hot dinners in October, but will keep you informed.

Please could you ensure that you send your children in with a water bottle each day. This is the water that the children are drinking throughout the day. If children do not have a bottle, they are not having anything to drink during the day; and this is not appropriate. Children should bring their bottles home each night and this should be washed, refilled and brought back the next day.

We are aware that with cold and flu season arriving, there is some confusion as to when you should be seeking a Covid test for your child or any other family members. Please find attached a letter from the NHS, with clarification on when you should seek a Covid test; I hope that you will find this useful.

Masks – All parents <u>must</u> wear masks whilst queuing to drop off/pick up children, or when on the school site. The only exception should be if you have a medical condition which prevents you from wearing a mask. In addition, all visitors to the school office will now have their temperature tested and asked to scan the QR code for the NHS Track & Trace App.

Flu Vaccinations - These will be taking place on Monday 5th October for Reception to Year 6 children. A reminder that parents will need to complete an electronic consent form (one for each child) by visiting: <u>https://www.berkshireimmunisations.co.uk/Forms/Flu</u>. Please complete the form to indicate whether or not you are consenting to the flu vaccination.

PE Days – Apologies to Years 2 and 5 parents for the change in PE days. We had to amend their time table for the day, which meant that PE days had to be changed. Thank you for your patience.

Pick up and drop off. Please do no queue jump. Only one person per household may come onto the school site to collect a child. Older siblings will have to wait outside. We have kindly asked that pupils travelling home from Wexham Secondary School, go down Edmund's Way rather than Moat Drive. Reception and Year 1 parents, you are doing a great job at the Barn. Thank you for not stepping forward beyond the tables.
