### **Inset Day**



### Just so you don't forget...

#### School Applications

- Reception applications for September 2021 – online applications opened on Saturday 12<sup>th</sup> September and will close on Friday 15<sup>th</sup> January 2021.
- Secondary School applications for September 2021 (this applies to current Year 6 pupils) – online applications deadline is Saturday 31<sup>st</sup> October 2020. Please note that this is during the half term break so if you need any help you will need to contact us before half term starts.

#### Water Bottles & Lunches

A friendly reminder to all parents to remember to send their child/children in with their water bottle and lunch box (if they are having a packed lunch). We have had a few parent/children forgetting their lunches and water bottles and these are being dropped off throughout the day which is causing traffic within the office reception.

#### Lateness

### WEXHAM COURT PRIMARY SCHOOL SCHOOL UNIFORM

SCHOOL UNIFORM POLICY	
SWEAT SHIRT	Children should wear the school sweat shirt which is blue with a yellow emblem. No fleeces should be worn as the classrooms are sufficiently warm.
SHIRTS	Yellow polo shirts only.
SKIRTS & TROUSERS	Winter uniform: smart plain grey trousers, skirt or pinafores should be worn by boys or girls. Skirts should be of reasonable length. Black leggings or tights may be worn under skirts. Summer uniform: blue and white checked pinafores or grey shorts.
SHOES	Shoes should be smart, plain black and have a sensible heel height for moving around school. Trainers are NOT to be worn.
PE KIT	Plain white T-Shirt or polo shirt. Blue shorts, tracksuit bottoms or leggings. Plimssoles or trainers



Please note that trainers are not to be worn in School except for P.E or non-uniform days. No jewellery is to be worn; with the exception of a pair of stud earrings or religious items, which must be removed or covered on P.E days.
