### **School photographs - Wed 14th October**

### **World Mental Health day**

The overall theme this year is 'Mental Health for all'. We are celebrating the differences and similarities between us all by showcasing that we are 'the same but different'. We're looking at what makes each of us special, different or unique. We're looking at and celebrating diversity; we may look different to each other, but we have lots of things in common. Sometimes our differences on the surface, hide our similarities underneath.

### **Tapestry**

The children have started their tapestry, which will be displayed in the Barn and they have been busy tending to the various vegetable beds and Polytunnel. We have continued our extra sessions of PSHE and RE in order to give pupils time to talk about their experiences.

### **Local lockdown**

There is much speculation around as to whether schools will lock down from two weeks over half term. I do not have the answer to this, but I think it is unlikely. It is our hope that the schools remain



open and we can continue to provide the education they desperately need. Gaps in knowledge are emerging and teachers are helping pupils to recall previous learnt knowledge. This means that at times work will be difficult, but it is only through this hard thinking that pupils will excel. We are always mindful of the possibility of a lockdown and therefore teachers will be asking pupils if they have access to a PC/laptop and internet.

### **Phonics Screen Check**

The Phonics Screen Check (PSC) ordinarily takes place in summer term for Year 1 pupils. As it did not take place last year, it has been moved to Autumn term two. Therefore Year 2 will sit the PSC in Late November to Early December. The results will not be shared nor published. More important than this, is that the pupils have missed a lot of teaching here and therefore it is crucial that we immerse the pupils in phonics. The year 1 and 2 team will be sharing videos with you over the next few weeks. They are short and linked to the sound your child is struggling with. Please ensure they see it as much as possible and help them to identify the sounds as they read. Mrs Fotheringham will send a separate letter to parents soon.

### **End of Term**

Terms ends on Friday 23rd October at normal time. The children will return to school on Tuesday 3rd November. Upon their return we will tighten up all our routines such as punctuality and attendance, uniform and homework. In addition, teachers will tighten routines around the classroom such as how children sit (many are slouching) and handwriting. The learning of multiplication tables, spellings and reading. We have allowed time for pupils to readjust but it is time to pick up the pace and establish those firm expectations. We have a long road ahead of us where anything could happen.

- Secondary School applications for September 2021 (this applies to current Year 6 pupils) – online applications opened on Saturday 12th September and will close on Saturday 31st October 2020.
