Important Information

Dear Parents & Guardians,

It is cold outside! Having had a wonderfully colourful Autumn, we are set to have a cold but equally beautiful Winter. Make sure you stop to have a look at the secret wonders made visible by the frost. We need your help...queuing is a pain and nobody likes it but it is a part of life now. We changed the procedures following Parent feedback, right now it will remain as it is. We have staggered times in place to avoid long queues and to ensure that there are not too many Parents on the playground. A reminder that:

- If your child is in **Upper Primary (years 4 6) only, then your pick-up time is 3.20pm.** Do not arrive before then.
- If you have a child in **Lower and Upper Primary, then your time is 3.00pm to 3.20pm.** Please do not arrive after this.
- If you child is in Lower Primary only, your time is 3.00pm to 3.20pm.
- The gates will close on time at **8.45am and 3.20pm. No exceptions.**

The pick-up in the evening is very hard to manage, please work with us and understand that we are not traffic officers or attendants, we are Teachers who are trying to make things work for you and your children.

One of our school values is 'Community,' over the term, pupils have thought a lot about supporting their School community, over Christmas they will think about others outside our school. On the 17th December we will all have our Christmas School dinner, which is one of my favourite days. Pupils bring in a £1 or more and wear a Christmas jumper. Christmas Cards & Gifts


