Dear Parents, Guardians & Carers,

As you are aware, England is slowly coming out of lockdown. Today marks the opening of indoor restaurants, the rule of 6 being extended to indoor areas, entertainment venues like cinemas, theatres and bingo halls being re-opened etc.

Using messages around water safety and window safety, CCG decided to produce the video in response to increasing concerns about the distractions of mobile phones in particular and how use of electronic devices may impact on risks to supervision of babies and children.


