Important Information

Dear Parents, Guardians & Carers,

I hope you had a restful weekend and blessed Mother's Day if you celebrated.

Last week was really lovely...the children rushed into School and settled in very quickly. The Senior Leadership Team and I spent a lot of time working with the children to gage the progress they have made and identify any areas of confusion or gaps. Even with great online learning in place, we have to accept that pupils across the country will have missed key parts of the curriculum. Therefore, over the next few weeks we will be carrying out assessments, taking out small groups, asking children questions and supporting their learning in order to ensure our summer-term curriculum is fit for their needs.

To support their return to School, **children must arrive on time and in the correct uniform**. Trainers can only be worn on PE days. We have noticed pupils wearing hoodies, these are not part of the School uniform and they will not be allowed to wear them. While these little things seem trivial, they add up to form discipline and work ethic. Please see the attached the uniform list.

	SCHOOL UNIFORM POLICY
SWEAT SHIRT	Children should wear the school sweat shirt which is blue with a yellow emblem. No fleeces should be worn as the classrooms are sufficiently warm.
SHIRTS	Yellow polo shirts only.
SKIRTS & TROUSERS	Winter uniform: smart plain grey trousers, skirt or pinafores should be worn by boys or girls. Skirts should be of reasonable length. Black leggings or tights may be worn under skirts. Summer uniform: blue and white checked pinafores or grey shorts.
SHOES	Shoes should be smart, plain black and have a sensible heel height for moving around school. Trainers are NOT to be worn.
PE KIT	Plain white T-Shirt or polo shirt. Blue shorts, tracksuit bottoms or leggings. Plimsoles or trainers



Please note that trainers are not to be worn in School except for P.E or non-uniform days. No jewellery is to be worn; with the exception of a pair of stud earrings or religious items, which must be removed or covered on P.E days.

During a meeting with local Head Teachers this morning, I was informed that Slough Borough Council has appointed a few police officers to patrol Slough and reinforce restrictions. They will be visiting local Primary Schools to ensure that parents are maintaining a distance during wait times. This is an issue in all Schools and one that we just have to manage. Thus, I prompt you to maintain a 2-meter distance and to wear a face mask when queuing and when on the School grounds. We are trying our hardest to ensure nobody queue jumps etc. but we cannot monitor who is wearing a mask outside or whether you are lining up 2 meters apart. This is **YOUR** responsibility!

Additionally, if your child is showing symptoms, please keep them at home and book a covid test – your child should only return to School if they receive a negative Covid-19 Test result.

We have received a complaint from a resident from the neighbouring road where parents are parking in front of driveways. Please can you ensure that you **do not park in residents' driveways**. Parking in front of and in other residents' drives is disruptive. Also parking in front of driveways with white markings (elongated H) is illegal and parents who purposely ignore these marking will be issued a Penalty Charge Notice if caught by Traffic Wardens.

Please plan your journeys and walk to School if you live within a walking distance. If you must drive, please plan your journey and leave ample time to park away from the School and walk the remainder of your journey.

Finally, the pupils took advantage of being outside last week, they started work on the polytunnel and planted their sunflower seeds. I know Miss Nawaz is determined to grow the tallest sunflower this year!
