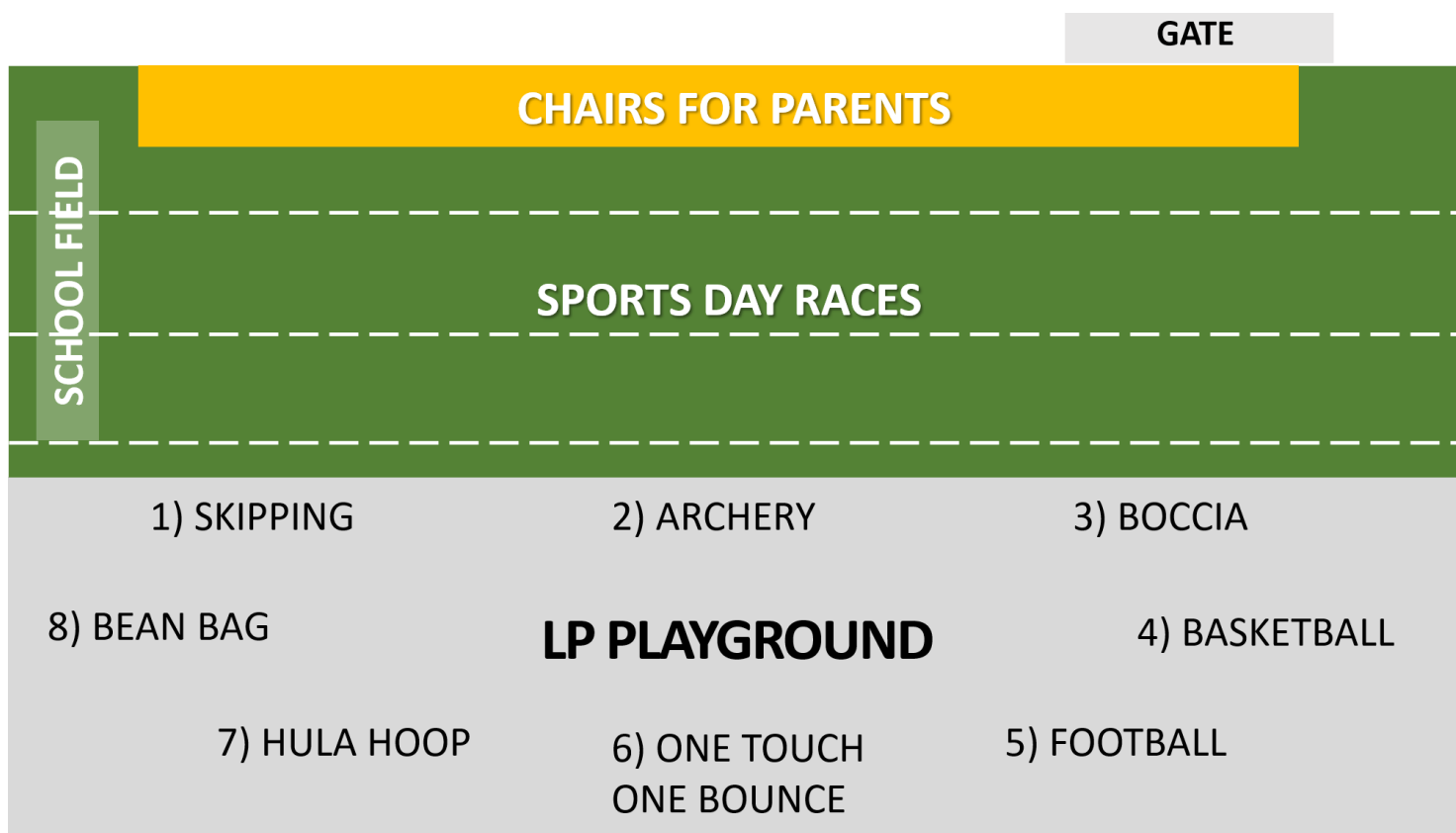
Messages & Reminders
