Dear Parents and Carers,

We have been liaising with Slough Borough Council on how to make Moat Drive safer for our children. We will be introducing a 'School Street' for a period of 7 weeks, starting on the 3<sup>rd</sup> of November. During the times 8.00am to 9.00am and 3.00pm to 4.00pm, restriction will apply and Moat Drive will be closed to any through traffic. The residents have had information regarding this and now we are informing you. I have attached a quick and very easy survey for you to complete and contribute to making the road safer and more pleasant for our children.

Pick up and drop off – Years 4-6 children can go straight into school in the morning when the gate opens. Please therefore could parents stand to the left side of the pavement to allow children to walk on the right side of the pavement, straight through the gate. If you are late after school to pick up your child, the class teacher has to remain in the classroom until you arrive. This means that they are late for training or other commitments. Therefore, anyone who is persistently late, will be charged at the full after school club rate which is £5.50 per child.

Masks – A reminder that all parents must wear masks whilst queuing to drop off/pick up children, or when on the school site. In addition, all visitors to the school office must have their temperature tested and must scan the QR code for the NHS Track & Trace App. Only one visitor may enter the office at a time. Therefore, if you are late in the morning, please be aware that you will have to wait in line.



You will have received a letter last week about "Hotober". You read that correctly! We are officially returning to hot dinners today and I am sure the children will love it. Food will continue to be delivered to the children in their classrooms by canteen staff. In addition, if your child is continuing to bring in packed lunches, please ensure that this does not contain unhealthy, high in fat, or high in sugar foods such as crisps, chocolates,

sweets etc. We are an active movement school and we are keen to encourage children to get active again and make healthy choices, following the lockdown.

We are aware that there were technical issues with pre-ordering yours child's meal through souic sQuid. We will be in touch when these issues are resolved, but in the meantime your child can order in school at registration in the normal way.

**Reception** applications for September 2021 - online applications opened on Saturday 12<sup>th</sup> September and will close on Friday 15<sup>th</sup> January 2021.

**Secondary School** applications for September 2021 (this applies to current Year 6 pupils) – online applications opened on Saturday 12<sup>th</sup> September and will close on Saturday 31<sup>st</sup> October 2020.

Pupils in Reception - Year 6 had their flu vaccinations today so hopefully this help with the seasonal infections. Please could I ask that you make sure your children are coming to school with appropriate clothes for the weather and coats that are clearly labelled.

# S4K Home Club at Wexham Court!




